CLOCK TOWER TO POST OFFICE LANE

Distance: 1 mile

Starting Point: Atworth Clock Tower (reference 863660 on the OS map 156)

- 1 Proceed up Bradford Road passing the 18th c Independent Church and turn left into Coronation Road. Continue straight ahead and eventually down a grassy track to a metal gate with a stile on the left. Cross into the field *[Pennings]* and walk to the end of the stone boundary wall on your left.
- 2 Next walk diagonally to the left across the field [this field -Ten Acres- was previously seperated from Pennings] to a metal gate in the left hand corner. Turn to your right into the field called Pieces and follow the hedge on your right southwards.
- 3 At the corner turn left and continue to walk within this field's boundaries. Follow the hedge on your right all the way along to a stone wall. Carry on keeping the stone wall on your right until you reach a metal style that gives access on to Post Office Lane.
- 4 Walk down the lane until you reach the A 365. Note the plaque on the last house on the left hand side showing the location of the Village pound. Turn left at the main road and continue along the pavement back to the Clock Tower.
