

## Stories from Healing on the Streets of Melksham - July 2010.

### Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

An elderly gentleman man with arthritis was prayed for. In particular, in his left knee for which he needed a walking stick. After prayer, although not completely cured, he said he did feel there was an improvement in his condition.

A man in his mid-thirties came for prayer. Sixteen years earlier he had been seriously injured in a road traffic accident which left him in a coma. He was still suffering with brain injuries and a damaged spine. After prayer he had increased mobility in his back and could bend and twist without feeling pain. He walked off to Blockbusters and on his return he told us that his walking had improved significantly. Previously he found it difficult to walk in a straight line and he staggered as if he were drunk. Now he could walk briskly in a straight line!

### Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

A middle-aged lady was prayed for, for a number of things. One of these, pain in her back, was greatly eased when she got up from the chair after prayer. Two weeks later on 24<sup>th</sup> July she reported that she was still enjoying the effect of a significant improvement.

### Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

A Belgian lad aged around 12 or 13 was prayed for. He had dropped a trailer on his foot. His foot was painful but nothing was broken. Movement was severely restricted because of the pain. After prayer there was no more pain and therefore plenty of movement. He had come with his parents so after showing his healed foot to his dad the lad came back and gave a hug to those who had prayed for him.

One of the ladies that we had prayed for last week came to tell us her leg wound was beginning to heal. She had received prayer for this last week as well as some treatment from the ulcer clinic.

### Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2010:

Sometimes we hear about healings after the event. Here are a couple of stories heard about on 18<sup>th</sup> July at one of the Melksham Churches...

A lady came to asking for prayer saying "I've been sleeping really well since I was prayed for at HOTS last year, just until these last few weeks."

Earlier this year, in April, the sister-in-law of a lady with endometriosis (sp) came to be prayed for at HOTSOM on behalf of her sister-in-law. The doctors had told the lady that one of the best ways to control the problem was to get pregnant. However, she and her husband had been trying for several years without success. This week at a medical examination the doctor told the lady she was pregnant and it seems that she became so at about the time her sister-in-law sat in for her in prayer.

### Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

A middle-aged lady who had sprained her ankle a couple of weeks ago received prayer. Before prayer the ankle was stiff with restricted movement. About 15 minutes after receiving prayer the lady reported that her ankle was significantly looser and movement much less restricted.

### Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2010:

Today we received an update about a lady that we'd prayed earlier this year on 1<sup>st</sup> May. At that time we wrote the following...

An elderly lady with a frozen shoulder received prayer. After prayer there was a significant improvement with the mobility of the shoulder.

"I asked a lady in Bath if she wanted prayer, and she said that she had been with her friend in Melksham and her friend had been prayed for. She had a bad shoulder and by the time they had walked to the end of the street, it was totally healed!"

## Stories from Healing on the Streets of Melksham - August 2010.

### Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

A man with a sore big toe on his right foot was prayed for. The toe was painful and movement restricted. Although he had been prescribed with two different pain killers they neither of them had eased the pain - the tablets only made him feel drowsy and the cream had no discernible effect. According to doctors the pain and restricted movement was the result of the toe bone growing some additional. After prayer there was a definite improvement - movement in the toe was more free and the pain had reduced.

Another man with a sore foot received prayer. After prayer the man reported that the pain had "eased considerably".

### Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

A man suffering with depression received prayer. As he was prayed for his depression lifted as he began to feel the love of God.

Today we heard from an elderly lady who was prayed for last year. At the time she was being troubled by kids disturbing her in her home by knocking on her door and running away. This was a frequent occurrence and was greatly troubling the lady and making her feel unsafe. After praying about her situation the door-knocking stopped and she has hardly been troubled since.

Today we heard from a lady for whom we prayed a few months ago. The lady's niece lives in the USA and had cervical cancer. Therefore, the lady who sat on the chairs and we prayed for her 'in proxy' of her niece. We heard that when the niece visited the hospital for her next check-up the doctors were confounded because there was no sign of the cervical cancer! Praise the Lord!

## Stories from Healing on the Streets of Melksham - September 2010.

### Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

Today we heard from an elderly man for whom we've prayed before and who received healing for two conditions in August/September last year. He occasionally drops by for a chat but despite being healed he still remains sceptical about the existence of God and of Jesus. We prayed for him last week because he was getting pains in his chest when he eats - sort of wind or indigestion but higher up than the stomach. He told us that after prayer last week the pains/discomfort hadn't reappeared.

### Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

We prayed for a lady who had several stress-related illnesses. Shortly after receiving prayer she said she was feeling much better. In particular, her tinnitus (something that she hadn't mentioned) was cured.

We prayed for a lady with a number of complaints including a bad back and no feeling in her right foot. During prayer she started to regain feeling in her foot and began to sense warmth flowing up her leg. We're still not sure what God was doing but He was definitely doing something.

### Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

We met a lady who had received prayer about 9 months previously. At that time she was keen that her daughter would be able to conceive. Her daughter gave birth last week!

We met a lady that we prayed for last winter. We hadn't seen her passing through for some months, though last winter she walked by almost every week. She didn't have time to stop for prayer but she did have time to tell us that her cancer was now completely clear!

We met an elderly couple who we prayed for several months ago. They said that since receiving prayer they were feeling very much better and that they would come back some time for a 'top up'.

Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

A lady that we prayed for last week (2<sup>nd</sup> October) came back to encourage us and to give thanks to God for answered prayers. Last week we had prayed for a number of complicated and confidential relational issues. This morning she told us that she had experienced had been major breakthrough in most of these.

## Stories from Healing on the Streets of Melksham - November 2010.

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

Today we heard from two people who had received prayer for healing on previous occasions.

Earlier this year, on June 26<sup>th</sup> we reported that a gentleman received prayer for the condition of pernicious anaemia. The next time he had a blood test he was told that although he still has anaemia it is no longer pernicious. Today the same gentleman told us that whereas previously he needed a blood transfusion every 6 weeks, his condition was still improving and that he was now up to 9 weeks between transfusions.

Last week (30<sup>th</sup> November) a gentleman who had suffered a stroke came for prayer. He was very much improved this week and consequently came back for more prayer.

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> November 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

Today we heard from some people who had received prayer for healing on previous occasions:

Earlier this year we prayed for a gentleman who had cellulitis on the knee, possibly as the result of a spider bite. He came back to tell us that it was better.

On 13<sup>th</sup> February we told the story of a pregnant lady who had been diagnosed as having a growth in her womb as well as the embryo. This was deemed to be life threatening to mother and unborn child. A further examination at Charring Cross Hospital diagnosed that she was pregnant with twins. Today she came to thank us for praying and to tell us the final outcome - not a growth, not twins, but a very healthy baby weighing in at 10lbs 11oz. God is good!

A lady returned to give thanks having received prayer on behalf of her niece several weeks ago. Her niece had been diagnosed with ovarian cancer so (earlier this year) the lady had sat in the chair and received prayer 'in proxy' for her niece. Praise God, her niece is now clear of cancer!

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2010 - by bus stop near Jason Kent Estate Agents:

A gentleman in a wheel chair for whom we had prayed for earlier in the month returned for more prayer. As he result of a stroke he was paralysed down his left side. He came back because, after prayer, the mobility in his left leg had improved.

Today he confirmed that the pains in his chest when he eats (sort of wind or indigestion but higher up than the stomach) hadn't returned (except on a few occasions when he has swallowed too much).
