INTERCESSORY PRAYER

Please follow these points when leading Intercessory Prayers in the morning meetings:

- ✓ The time is for you to lead the church in interceding for others. This means taking the gathered people before Father to pray for other people and situations outside the local church.
- ✓ Focus on international, national & local issues. Find topics that people in the congregation will be concerned about.
- ✓ Keep the prayer time to no more than 5 minutes; otherwise you will take time away from later parts of the meeting.
- ✓ Try to use simple language and avoid jargon. This is especially important in Family Services.
- ✓ You may find it helpful to write the prayer out in full, or just some headings, so that you feel more able to pray with confidence.
- ✓ Make sure that you use the microphone so that everyone can hear. Speak slowly and clearly.
- ✓ Please use an end of row seat for the meeting so that you can get out to the front with minimum delay.
